



## Boyan Maga School Rules Policy

### Indoors

- a) Pupils are expected to walk inside the building.
- b) Going up the stairs on the left hand-side, and coming down the stairs on the left hand side by the banister.
- c) Consequence: The pupils will be asked to go back and do it again in the appropriate manner. 'Action replay'.
- d) Pupils should use indoor voices when in the building
- e) The pupils need to wear indoor shoes all the time.
- f) The pupils have to keep their pegs tidy.
- g) Toilet should be used by a maximum of two pupils of each class, at any one time during class time. No gathering in toilets.
- h) The pupils are requested to use toilets before or after snacks. At the end of break the pupils will go directly to their classroom for lessons. This is to facilitate the prompt start of lessons after break. If the pupil needs to use toilets, he/she needs to go to class first and then ask permission from teacher.
- i) Pupils have to respect the environment in which they work and play. No writing on desks, standing on chairs, tables or toilet seats or making walls dirty or graffiti. j) Kitchen and basement are out of bounds.

### Outdoor and playground

- a) Zero tolerance for bad language or rudeness towards children or member of staff.  
Consequence: Detention (see Positive Behaviour Policy).
- b) Sticks can be used for building, not to play fight or to point towards others. Consequence: The pupil will be taken to the indoor duty teacher, and miss playtime.
- c) Pupils have to show respect to the environment in which they live and work. No greenery or plants should be damaged, no writing or marks to be made on the building, nor climbing on the walls, ledges or fences.  
Consequences: The pupil/s will be taken to the indoor duty-teacher and miss playtime. In the case of writing on desks or dirtying walls or surfaces, the pupils will be requested to clean it up during their break-time.
- d) The pupils have to stay within boundaries of premises. Consequences: If the pupil/s leave the premises without permission they will have detention.

e) In wet condition there is no playing in middle grassed area of park. Consequence: the pupil/s will be taken to the indoor teacher on duty and miss playtime.

f) Pupils must have wet weather gear at all times at school to be worn in wet conditions.

g) Sports equipment/toys must be checked and approved by the Class Teacher before being allowed to be taken outside.
